Closures: *Day Care for Dogs is closed the following holidays:*

We are also closed if the forecast predicts a day of continuous moderate to heavy rain. We will email and cancel before 6 a.m. that morning. Please check your email on rainy days. If you did not receive an email, and are unsure, please call 760-207-5267. There will be a message if we have cancelled service for that day.

We do offer "potty stops" on rain-out days. This service is \$15.00 to let your dog(s) out mid-day (between 11 a.m. -2 p.m.) Please let us know and we will put you on an automatic list.

Cancellations: You must call to add/cancel your dog to the daily schedule anytime before 8 p.m. on the evening before the day of pick up.

Scrapes and Scratches: During normal dog play, your dog may sustain minor injuries. All play is carefully monitored to avoid injury. Any injury will be brought to your attention upon drop-off. A staff member will contact you by phone or email and leave a note if you are not at home.

Our Services: We understand that your dog is very important to you and would like to tell you what your dog might experience in a typical day. You can be confident that your dog(s) is in the best of hands as proven through our program's success since 1999. At Kamp Kanine we have the best dogs in the county and we take pride in bringing them home tired and happy.

Kamp Kanine is open Monday through Friday and includes pick-up and drop-off delivery service. With the exception of major holidays and rain-out days, our vans arrive to pick up the dogs between 7 a.m. and 10 a.m.

Upon arriving back at the facility, a typical morning begins with grouping the dogs appropriately and ensuring the dogs are happy and comfortable with one another. We introduce first-timers to their new friends, and monitor the activities. While in the fenced enclosures, the dogs are always off leash with 5 to 20 other furry friends. Most dogs begin the morning with a little bit of fetch, chase and wrestling as well as lots of attention from the Kamp Kounselors.

We drive the dogs home to arrive typically between 2 p.m. and 5 p.m. (depending on traffic). Our drop-off route is normally the same as our pick-up. When the dogs are on their way home they are either asleep or relaxing with their van mates. Your dog will usually come home "dog-tired"!

New dogs may experience muscle soreness from all the exercise and play and may not recharge until the next day while others may recharge in the evening. In some cases we restrict the amount of exercise for a dog, especially if the dog is slowing down with age, needs more rest than is usual and for very large dogs who need to be monitored.
